What Will You Do With Jesus?

Come with me on a journey as we go with Jesus from supper; the eleven follow, each deep in thought. This quiet, weary, and sorrowful procession goes down the path towards the Mount of Olives as the gentle breeze almost mockingly plays with the vines by the path.

Jesus knew what lay ahead. A tear would escape as he thought of His mom, family, disciples, and followers.

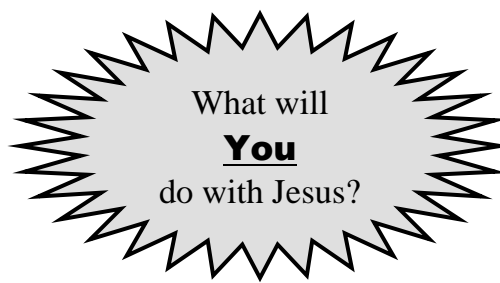

What Will You Do With Jesus?

Pilate releases Jesus to the mob, and orders him to the scourging pole, which the Romans call "halfway death" Picture our dear Lord, who missed a night of sleep, sweated in the garden, with loss of blood, bruises from beatings, muscles spasms from the scourging, and tears of love mixed with sweat, blood, and spit on his face. His body now being very weak, they force Him to carry His cross as they play games of mockery on the pavement. His body gives out and He falls. After hitting, kicking, and yelling they eventually get Simon to carry the cross. Now at the top of the hill they push Him down on the cross, stretch out His arms and in each hand they drive a big rough nail. His body flinches with each blow. Then they grab His legs and drive the nail through them as well. His body writhes in pain. How many times they missed the nail and hit Him, we are not told. The soldiers pick up the cross and drop it in the hole. With a thud it hits the bottom as the flesh around the nails tears from the weight of the body. He is given vinegar mixed with gall to drink and His clothes are given away. A thief is also crucified on either side, while Barabbas (*a criminal*), has been released! People all around hurl insults at Him, along with one of the thieves also. Yet, in love, Jesus reaches out to the other thief who saw His need of Jesus.

As His life is almost gone, He cares about those that treated Him so cruelly and prays to His heavenly Father for them, "Father forgive them, for they know not what they do." After that He cried, "It is finished," and He died. He was pierced in His side; that precious blood and water flowed from His side. Sin's debt was paid! BUT...Praise be to God, on that glorious Easter morning, He Arose! The grave clothes, the grave, and the stone in front of the tomb could not hold Him. He is Risen! Victory! Satan, hell, death, and the grave are defeated. As you reflect this Easter season on the price Jesus paid for you to have eternal life, I ask you this question, "What will you do with Jesus?" Will you betray Him, like Judas? Will you deny Him, like Peter? Will you accuse him, like the religious people? Will you make fun of Him, like Herod? Will you try to ignore Him, like Pilate? Will you see your need of Him and accept Him, as the thief on the cross? What will you do with Jesus? Jesus loves you wherever you are. As long as you have life it is not too late to come to Him. The chorus of a song says it this way. "What will you do with Jesus? Neutral you cannot be; Someday your heart will be asking, What will He do with ME?"
