A safe place. What is a safe place? Why is it important? Over the years I have heard many statements and questions that help me understand the need of a safe place for hurting individuals. This raises a few questions: How did Jesus relate to individuals in pain, sin, bondage, etc.? How did Jesus make a safe place? As followers of Christ, how can we make a safe place?



How to Make a Safe Place for a Hurting Individual

If I could speak all the languages of earth and of angels, but didn't love others, I would only be a noisy gong or a clanging symbol. If I had the gift of prophecy, and if I understood all of God's secret plans and possessed all knowledge, and if I had such faith that I could move mountains, but didn't love others, I would have gained nothing. 1Cor. 13: 1,2 [NLT] Before you can do anything for anyone, it is important that you are able to receive God's love, let it flow through you, and give it away to others. You can do all kinds of great and wonderful things but without love, it means absolutely nothing. That is zero, nothing! The greatest thing you can ever do is to Love. That is not just *thinking* that you love someone, but that the individual *feels loved* by you. Look at the example Jesus left by how He cared about people.

- Accept a person where they are at. Regardless of how stuck or messed up things are, start there. DO NOT FIX.
- Focus to Understand. Try to understand their situation, what they are feeling, why they may have made wrong choices, where there is pain. DO NOT FIX.
- **3. Focus to Care.** Care about what is going on deep inside the person. You do not need a lot of answers, just care. **DO NOT FIX.**
- **4. Pray for.** Put yourself into their shoes and talk to the Lord on their behalf, how you think they would ask or talk to the Lord. Ask the Lord to show them how much He cares and hurts with them. **DO NOT FIX.**
- Never condemn the person. Keep the person and the problem separate. Care for the person. Speak life and God's love into the person. DO NOT FIX.
- 6. Never justify sin. Do not make them comfortable in their sin. If there is sin, do not excuse it, minimize it, exaggerate it, or blow it up. Call it what it is. DO NOT FIX.
- 7. Address the sin. You cannot force a person to change. They have to make that choice. Appeal to them, encourage them, help them see and understand the consequences of their sin. DO NOT FIX.
